II The people are young, gay, progressive and optimistic. Sports are improving here. There are a lot of football, volley and basketball teams. They are fond of swimming, tennis hunting and fishing to. At the Country Club we can practice Target Shooting.

DOMINICAN REPUBLIC - Rudy Espinal's new Dominican SW stn was supposed to be on the air testing (but not heard here. dnj) beginning early (GMT) 3/1, on a freq. between 6200 and 6300, with 15045 as the daylight frequency. Uncertain of the name, but possibly something like R. Caribe Mundial. Only the "Mundial" part is more or less certain. Supposed to be a new xmtr, not Clarin's. Jeff White reportedly assisting Rudy, at least in getting the station off the ground. (Bosco Tamale, via dnj)

GUATEMALA - 4825, R. Mam, 1/14, 0003-0006\*, Indian lang., w/ID, "TGMN, Radio Mam, Guatemala...Cabrican..." Some RTTY and QRM. (Paszkievicz)

# C.R. is Worried About Image

MINISTER of Information and Communications Armando Vargas announced this week that the Council of Government is discussing the advisability of creating a

separate institute to "broadcast a proper image of Costa Rica to the world."

The institute, according to Vargas, "would not necessarily be governmental but would work in coordination with the Foreign Ministry and could be financed by private enterprise."

Vargas, who two years ago created the first Information Ministry in the nation's history (public information previously had been handled in Costa Rica directly by the Chief Executives or by a designated press aide), charged that an international campaign against Costa Rica is being carried out in Mexico and in the United States.

The minister also said he is proposing to form "high-level commissions" to visit editors and media directors in the two countries, "to clarify our viewpoints on the Central American situation, and concretely the state of our relations with Nicaragua."

## RADIO EXTERIOR DE ESPAÑA INSTALA UN EMISOR EN COSTA RICA

Gracias al acuerdo firmado entre los Gobierno de España y Costa Rica, la radio española podrá ser escuchada en toda América. Según informó el director de Radio Exterior, Eduardo Sotillos, España ayudará a la formación de los radiofonistas costarricenses ofreciéndoles becas para que estudien en el Instituto Español de Radiotelevisión. Anunció además la potenciación de la red de corresponsales en Latinoamérica.
